

Privacy Policy

Kids' Chance Inc., of Missouri (MKC) employs physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard the security and integrity of personal information supplied to us. All MKC agents with access to personal information obtained on the MKC website are bound to adhere to this policy. MKC is committed to maintaining online security.

Personal Information that MKC May Collect Online

MKC does not collect personal information online. Visitors may download information from the MKC website, along with MKC's address, telephone number, and email address. MKC does not knowingly collect or maintain any personal information from children under the age of 13. In addition, no part of our website is designed with the purpose of attracting any person under age 13.

How MKC Uses Personal Information

Unless you otherwise consent, we will use your personal information only for the purpose for which it is submitted, such as to reply to your emails, handle your complaints, and process billing and business requests related to program participation. We will use such information to provide you with event notices, in program record-keeping, and as acknowledgement in our annual donors report. When submitting a donation, you may request MKC not publicly acknowledge your donation by checking the election box located on our donation materials. MKC will never sell or rent your personal information. MKC may release personal information under the following circumstances:

Computer Tracking and Cookies

Our website is not set up to track, collect or distribute personal information. Nor do we track the number of "hits" or visits to our website. A cookie is a small amount of data that is sent to your browser from a Web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. MKC uses non-identifying cookies to provide easier navigation and access to forms. You can still use MKC's website if your browser is set to reject cookies. Our cookies do not generate personal data, do

not read personal data from your machine, and are never tied to anything that could be used to identify you.
